

CORSEARCH TERMS & CONDITIONS*

(A) **Corsearch, Inc., and Corsearch B.V.** and their related entities, including but not limited to **TrademarkNow OY, Marketly LLC, Entura International Limited, and Incopro Limited** (collectively herein "**Corsearch**"), are service providers within the field of: Trademark Services, Brand Protection, Investigative Services, Domain Management, Content Protection, Case Management Services, Legal Survey (and any other present or future Corsearch Service).

(B) These Corsearch Terms & Conditions apply to any Statement of Work entered into by the Parties under this Agreement. If there is a conflict between these Corsearch Terms & Conditions and any Statement of Work, the Statement of Work will control.

1. Definitions

The following terms, when appearing with a capital letter, have the meaning set forth below:

"Affiliate" of a Party means any legal entity that directly or indirectly controls, is controlled by or is under common control with the Party. For the purpose of this definition, "control" means the power to direct, or to cause the direction of, through the ownership of voting securities, by contract or otherwise of more than 50% of the relevant legal entity;

"Agreement" means the Master Service Agreement between the Parties, which consists of: the Customer Details and Standard Contractual Clauses, Corsearch Terms & Conditions, Corsearch's Data Protection Terms and/or Corsearch Privacy Policy and any Statements of Work.

"Authorized Persons" means those Persons (whether personnel of Customer or its clients), who are authorized by Corsearch to have access to and use the Corsearch Platform(s). Authorized Persons does not include partners of Customer or client partners, unless agreed upon in writing between the Parties. For the avoidance of doubt, Customer is not permitted to expand the scope of this license to users which in any manner resell the Services.

"Brand Protection" means the services offered through Corsearch Affiliates, including Corsearch B.V. and/or Incopro

Limited, to detect, monitor or enforce the intellectual property rights of the Customer.

"Case Management" and **"Case Management Platform"** means the Services and platform which allow for the set-up and tracking of intellectual property and brand protection-related actions and management of cases.

"Confidential Information" has the meaning ascribed to it in Clause 10.2.

"Content Protection" means the services offered through Corsearch Affiliates, including; Marketly LLC, Entura International Limited and/or Incopro Limited, to remove infringing content, websites, hosting of infringing content of the Customer.

"Corsearch Platform(s)" means the proprietary platform which Corsearch makes accessible to Authorized Persons, which includes but is not limited to, the presently existing Trademark Platforms (Corsearch Global Platform, Trademark Search, Trademark Watch, TrademarkNow Platform), Brand Protection Platforms (ZERO and Talisman), Content Protection Platforms (those of the Corsearch subsidiaries: Marketly LLC, Entura International Limited and Incopro Limited) and Case Management Platforms, and (a) any future consolidated Corsearch platform, Enhancements or iterations of these platforms or new platforms provided by Corsearch for use by its Customers; and (b) any backup or copy of the Platforms which is to be maintained and operated by Corsearch as necessary to perform and deliver the Services hereunder.

"Customer" is the party listed in this Agreement.

"Customer Data" any and all data provided by Customer to Corsearch under the Agreement, including the information provided under the contract, legal or other documentation and materials and all information, reports, and analysis which has been loaded onto, created, edited, modified or otherwise produced by an Authorized Person or Customer as a result of using the Corsearch Platform(s). This does not include public information or output otherwise produced by Corsearch or the Corsearch Platform(s) that is not designated within the scope of Services delivered to the Customer.

“Disclosing Party” means the Party disclosing Confidential Information to the other Party.

“Domain Management” are stand-alone or supplementary services, to monitor and protect the domain name portfolio of the Customer. Separate Terms and Conditions may apply in relation to Domain Management Services.

“Enhancement” means any update, upgrade, new version, modification, additions, developments, improvements or enhancement to the Corsearch Platform(s).

“Execution Date” means the date listed as the “Execution Date” in the Agreement or, if not specified, the date the Customer signs the Agreement. This is the date this Master Services Agreement is deemed valid. Any Commencement Date listed in a Statement of Work is the date the services under the SOW are agreed to commence.

“Force Majeure” means any cause beyond a Party’s control, as a result of which such Party is unable to perform its obligations under the Agreement. Such causes include but are not limited to acts of God, labour conflicts, acts of war or civil disruption, governmental regulations, public utility failures, network failures, industry-wide shortages of labour or material, natural disasters or health crises.

“Hosting Sub-Contractor” means the entity selected by Corsearch to host Corsearch Platform(s), including not limited to AWS, to provide the Services hereunder.

“Intellectual Property Rights” means any copyright, database right, design right, rights to inventions (whether or not patentable), patents, patent applications, know-how, trademarks, service marks, trade secrets and any rights similar or analogous to any of the foregoing, in each case: (a) whether arising by operation of law, registrable or registered; (b) whether now known or in the future created; (c) in each and every part of the world; (d) for the full term of such rights together with any extensions; (e) including (without limitation) all future rights where capable of present assignment; and (f) with the right to claim for past infringement.

“Investigative Services” are stand-alone or supplementary services, accessible within the Corsearch Platform(s) or through the

Corsearch Intelligence, and/or Operations Departments. These services include but are not limited to: online and offline investigations, enforcement activities, and global test purchases.

“Legal Survey” are services to show measured, evidence-based outcomes relating to intellectual property rights.

“Party”/“Parties” means in singular either Corsearch, by and through its related entities, or the Customer and in plural both Corsearch and Customer.

“Person” means an individual, a partnership, a limited liability company, a joint venture, a corporation, a trust, an unincorporated organization, a division or operating group of any of the foregoing, a government or any department or agency thereof, or any other legal entity.

“Personal Data” means “personal data” as defined in the General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament.

“Power of Authority” documented authorization by Customer to Corsearch giving Corsearch the authority to act on its behalf in relation to any Services listed herein or provided in a Statement of Work.

“Purpose” means the relationship between the Parties and the objectives of the Customer in relation to the Services provided through this Agreement or any Statements of Work.

“Recipient Party” means, in respect of an item of Confidential Information, the Party receiving that item of Confidential Information.

“Report Data” means text, audio, video, graphics and other information and data available by means of the Services by and through the Corsearch Platform(s) or reports in relation to the provision of Services under the Agreement and any Statements of Work. This does not include Customer Data.

“Services” means all services to be performed and delivered by Corsearch under the Agreement or in any Statement of Work.

“Source Materials” means the source code, executable code, software build process

documentation and database scheme, coding guide and standards, other technical documents relating to the software, enhancements and such other text files in such form that they can be compiled or interpreted into object code together with all technical information and documentation which will allow the use, reproduction, modification and enhancement of the software comprising the Corsearch Platform(s), including information generated from the Corsearch Platform(s) through public source and clustering technology which enables the software to function and produce output.

“**Standard Support Services**” has the meaning ascribed to it in Clause 3.2.

“**Statement of Work**” means order specifying the Services to be provided to Customer or its affiliates.

“**Sub-Contractors**” means such sub-contractors of Corsearch, who are permitted to act in accordance with Clause 15.

“**Subscription**” means set term offering of the Service, specified in any Statement of Work.

“**Term**” has the meaning given to it in Clause 8.1.

“**Trademark Services**” are computer-generated and/or analyst based trademark search and watch services offered through the Corsearch Platform(s).

2. Licenses, Intellectual Property Rights and Ownership

2.1 License to the Corsearch Platform(s)

2.1.1 Corsearch grants to the Customer for the term of the Agreement a non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable and worldwide license to access and use the Corsearch Platform(s), for the Customer’s own business purposes.

2.1.2 During the Term, the Customer may, without additional license, permit the Authorized Persons to have access to, and use the Corsearch Platform(s) for the Customer’s own business purposes in the manner contemplated by the Agreement, and any Statement of Work.

2.2 Access to the Corsearch Platform(s)

2.2.1 The Customer will authorize new Authorized Persons to the Corsearch Platform(s) in accordance with the procedures established

by Corsearch and any Statement of Work. Customer shall not permit any third party (not an Authorized Person) to use the Services or Corsearch Platform(s) without the prior written consent of Corsearch.

2.2.2 The Authorized Persons accounts (“**User Accounts**”) are personal to each Authorized Person and their credentials must be kept secure and confidential at all times. Customer acknowledges and agrees that Authorized Persons are responsible for the security of their account, including, where applicable, for failure to safeguard their User Accounts or allowing any third party (person or entity) to access the Corsearch Platform(s) through unauthorized use of their User Account. Customer, and/or Authorized Persons, agree to immediately notify Corsearch of any unauthorized use of their User Account.

2.2.3 The Customer shall be fully liable for the actions and omission of its Authorized Users.

2.3 Intellectual Property Rights

2.3.1 (a) Without limiting the scope of the Intellectual Property Rights of Corsearch third party licensors (including national Trademark and Patent Offices) Customer acknowledges that Corsearch and/or its licensors, as applicable, own Intellectual Property Rights in: (i) the Services (excluding Customer Data); and (ii) the know-how in relation to the Services.

(b) All Intellectual Property Rights in the Corsearch Platform(s) (except in the Customer Data provided by the Customer), the Source Materials and the Enhancements shall remain vested in Corsearch and no Intellectual Property Rights are assigned or otherwise transferred to the Customer.

2.3.3 Corsearch warrants that it has the full legal right to license the data on the Corsearch Platform(s) and that the use of Corsearch Platform(s) by the Customer or Corsearch under the Agreement does not infringe on the Intellectual Property Rights of any third party.

2.3.4 Corsearch Platform(s), including its additions, developments, enhancements and improvements, may not be modified, reverse engineered, redistributed, sold, publicly displayed, licensed, rented, or otherwise provided to a third party or commercially exploited.

2.4 Intellectual Property Rights and ownership of Customer Data or Reports

2.4.1 Customer shall retain title to any Customer Data delivered by Customer to Corsearch and any Customer tailored reports provided by Corsearch to the Customer as part of the

- Services, but not including Corsearch licensed information provided therein. The Report Data available through the Services are exclusively for Customer's internal professional use only and therefore, Corsearch grants to Customer a limited license to redistribute the Report Data available via the Services to its employees and/or professional clients, as necessary for such professional use.
- 2.4.2 The Customer warrants that no Customer Data infringes on any Intellectual Property Rights of any third party.

2.5 No Publication

Nothing in this Agreement gives either Party the right to use any of the other Party's trade names, trademarks, service marks, logos, or domain names, without the consent of the other Party.

3. The Services

Corsearch will provide the Customer with the Services described in a Statement of Work.

3.1 Trademark Services

Corsearch turnaround times for Trademark Services are calculated in working days, starting from the day following receipt of the Customer's order. Corsearch accepts no responsibility for delays following 'Force Majeure' event, a strike or a similar cause, a system breakdown, network failure or failures of the postal services, private or public, or resulting from unpaid invoices.

3.2 Support Services

Corsearch shall provide Customer with the following support services ("**Standard Support Services**"):

- (a) Services of the Corsearch client management support function (collectively "**Client Manager**") Monday through Friday, standard business hours per time zone and Customer location (or as specified in the Statement of Work);
- (b) Access to the Corsearch Platform(s) twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week, except as noted in 3.5.2.;
- (c) Reports on the overall performance and usage of the Corsearch Platform(s) as used by Customer based upon metrics to be mutually determined by the Parties, and as prepared by the Client Manager.

3.3 Hosting and Off-Site Back Up of Data

- 3.3.1 Corsearch shall host its Corsearch Platform(s) or, in its sole discretion, arrange

for it to be hosted by its Hosting Sub-Contractor and ensure that the level of hosting service provided is fit for the Purpose. If Corsearch elects to have the Corsearch Platform(s) hosted by a Hosting Sub-Contractor, it shall comply with the requirements of Clause 15.

- 3.3.2 Corsearch shall back up all data no less often than on a nightly basis to an offsite backup location.

3.4 Proper functioning and maintenance of the Corsearch Platform(s)

- 3.4.1 Corsearch shall ensure that:

- (a) unless the specific requirements of the Agreement require different practices, Corsearch shall run and operate its Corsearch Platform(s) and perform the Services in accordance with good industry standards,
- (b) Corsearch applies and utilizes such information security techniques, measures, tools and protection as is necessary and consistent with industry and compliance standards in the hosting and provision of its Corsearch Platform(s) and performance of the Services.

- 3.4.2 Corsearch may, upon at least seven (7) days' prior written notice to the Customer or with the prior consent of the Customer on less than seven (7) days' prior written notice, take down its Corsearch Platform(s) for scheduled maintenance, upgrades or new releases.

4. Financial and payment terms

4.1 Fees

- 4.1.1 Customer will pay all fees specified in the respective Statements of Work. Except as otherwise specified herein or in a Statement of Work, (i) fees are based on Services and Subscriptions purchased and not actual usage, (ii) payment obligations are non-cancellable and fees paid are non-refundable, and (iii) quantities purchased cannot be decreased during the relevant Subscription term.

- 4.1.2 As expressly provided in the applicable Statement of Work, renewal pricing will be based upon the applicable Corsearch pricing at the time of renewal. Pricing adjustments are customized and generally reflect volume or term commitments by Customer.

4.2 Invoicing and payment

Customer acknowledges and agrees that this Agreement will dictate all invoicing and payment terms.

- 4.2.1 Corsearch will invoice Customer in advance and in accordance with the relevant

- Statement of Work. Unless otherwise stated in the Statement of Work, invoiced fees are due net thirty (30) days from the invoice date.
- 4.2.2 Customer is responsible for providing complete and accurate billing and contact information to Corsearch and notifying Corsearch of any changes to such information.
 - 4.2.3 Corsearch is not responsible for invoices not processed properly by the Customer, or Customer's Accounting Department.
 - 4.2.4 Corsearch will not be bound by Customer Accounting Department's pre-determined invoice deadlines. All invoices must be paid for undisputed and delivered Services, as stated in 4.2.1 above, as issued. Any late payments will be subject to the fees as described herein.
 - 4.2.5 If the Customer uses a service for invoice submission which charges a processing, submission or related administration fee to Corsearch, Corsearch will charge back this fee to the Customer on the subsequent Corsearch invoice processed.
 - 4.2.6 All payments under the Agreement shall be made in currency reflected on the invoice or as agreed to by the Parties through a Statement of Work.
 - 4.2.7 If the Customer has any issue regarding an invoice it must report the issue to Corsearch in writing within ten (10) business days.
 - 4.2.8 In the event of any non-payment of the fees due under the Agreement and with Corsearch having provided written notice of non-payment to the Customer, Corsearch may after thirty (30) days of non-payment suspend the Services and suspend access of the Customer and any Authorized Persons to the Corsearch Platform(s) until such time full payment has been made.
 - 4.2.9 If any invoiced amount not received by Corsearch by the due date as provided in 4.2.1 above, then without limiting Corsearch's rights or remedies, (a) late charges may accrue at the interest rate of 1.5% of the outstanding amount due per month or the maximum rate permitted by law, whichever is higher, and/or (b) Corsearch may condition future Subscription renewals and Statements of Work on payment terms shorter than those specified above.
- 4.3 Payment and collection of applicable taxes**
All fees set forth in the Agreement are exclusive of applicable taxes and duties, including any taxes or VAT and/or applicable sales or use tax. The Customer will provide Corsearch with any information Corsearch may reasonably request in order to determine

whether Corsearch is obligated to collect VAT, sales or use tax from the Customer, including the Customer's VAT or taxpayer identification number, as well as tax exemption certificate or comparable documents, if applicable.

5. Indemnity

- 5.1 Subject to the limitations of liability set out in Clause 6, each Party agrees to indemnify and defend the other Party from and against all claims, actions, proceedings, costs (including reasonable legal fees) expenses, losses, damages (other than consequential damages) and liabilities arising from the Party's material breach of its obligations under this Agreement.
- 5.2 Corsearch agrees to indemnify the Customer from and against all claims, actions, proceedings, costs (including reasonable legal fees), expenses, losses, damages (other than consequential damages) and liabilities arising from any claim by a third party that the use of the Services under the Agreement infringes such third party's Intellectual Property Rights.
- 5.3 The Customer agrees to indemnify and defend Corsearch from and against all claims, actions, proceedings, costs (including reasonable legal fees), expenses, losses, damages (other than consequential damages) and liabilities arising from any claim by a third party that: (1) Customer Data violates any civil or criminal law or regulation, or infringes such third party's Intellectual Property Rights; (2) damages or claims resulting from Corsearch reporting or taking actions instructed by the Customer, and/or under its authorization, as specified in Clause 6 and by and through the Power of Authority; (3) when Customer independently uses data from the Corsearch Platform(s) or Report Data and/or takes action independently with Corsearch Platform(s).

6. Liability

6.1 Limitation of liability

- 6.1.1 Except in relation to its liability arising from Clauses 5 (Indemnity), Clause 10 (Confidentiality) and in relation to any subpoenas, legal orders, demands or requests for information, each Party's aggregate liability under the Agreement shall under no circumstances exceed the payments to which Corsearch would be entitled to invoice the Customer in the most recent calendar year.

6.2 Authorization

- 6.2.1 Customer acknowledges that Corsearch acts under the authorization and instructions of the Customer in the creation, production and action taken on behalf of the Customer in relation to its Brand Protection, Content Protection, Domain and Investigative Services and/or through the other relevant Services provided under this Agreement. If Corsearch is instructed to provide Services hereunder including but not limited to sending take down notices and/or purchasing products on Customer's behalf, Customer will provide the required Power of Authority during the onboarding process.
- 6.2.2 Corsearch is not responsible for third party claims resulting from or related to the instructed actions or Services provided.

6.3 Accuracy of Customer Information

- 6.3.1 Customer acknowledges and agrees that the performance of the Services is dependent on the timely completion of the Customer's responsibilities and obligations under this Agreement. Customer will be responsible for: (i) the timely preparation, delivery, accuracy and completeness of all required documentation, instructions and other information provided to Corsearch or inputted into the Corsearch Platform(s) in connection with the Services, and (ii) the consequences and accuracy of any instructions Customer may give to Corsearch. Customer is solely responsible for the creation of queries, selection of results and the accuracy and reliance on written instructions.

6.4 No Legal or Professional Advice

- 6.4.1 Information retrieved by Customer from Corsearch via the Corsearch Platform(s) (or in any other manner connection with Services) is not legal opinion and shall not be used or construed to be a legal advice for any purpose (including, as a final determination as whether a trademark is available for use or may be registered). Corsearch is not a law firm and is not engaged in rendering legal services. It is the responsibility of the Customer to obtain necessary legal counsel on any information retrieved from the Corsearch Platform(s) or in connection with the provision of the Service(s).
- 6.4.2 For Trademark Services (Search and Watch), Customer acknowledges that Trademark Search and Watch Reports involved human analysis and are therefore subjective in part. As such, Customer is solely responsible for the review, interpretation of the material, use of the Report and determining if further

research is needed and making a legal evaluation as necessary. Any liability related to the content or preparation of a Report is limited to the refund of the fees for the Report paid by the Customer.

6.5 Third Party Databases

Because Corsearch cannot independently verify the accuracy of the information maintained by the responsible government agency (including the USPTO or other national trademark and patent offices, Secretary of State Offices) or any other third party information sources of data (including any online platforms, ICANN-accredited registrar), Corsearch makes no guaranties, representations or warranties as to the full availability, accuracy or completeness of contents or results of the Services and expressly disclaim the full availability, accuracy, comprehensiveness, currency, or suitability of purpose of any of the information retrieved from Corsearch Platform(s) or Services. Corsearch cannot and does not accept any liability for any unavailability of the information in third party databases or for errors or omissions in the information obtained from third parties, as provided through the Corsearch Platform(s)

6.6 Data Retrieved Using Investigative Tools

Customer may be able to obtain additional information on referenced records through the use of investigative tools included in the Trademark Services. Corsearch expressly disclaims the accuracy and comprehensiveness of any data retrieved through these links. Data retrieved from the national trademark and patent offices, internet search engines, and Secretary of State Offices is retrieved through third-party providers, and Corsearch cannot be liable for errors, omissions, or currency of the data presented. It is the sole responsibility of Customer to determine if the information found, is, in fact, associated with the mark selected. In addition, the failure of the investigative tools to retrieve specific information cannot be construed as proof that the information does not exist or is not retrievable. Customer should always take reasonable steps to confirm information retrieved from the Service. If Customer accesses any third party public website through investigative tools and/or through Corsearch Platform(s) provided by Corsearch to Customer for Customer's convenience, Customer must agree to the third-party's user or access agreement posted on those sites. It

is wholly the responsibility of Customer to ensure compliance with all terms and conditions thereof. Customer understands and agrees that it is bound by any additional disclaimer of warranty included with any product or service provided by Corsearch. In particular, Customer is bound by any disclaimer included in a report retrieved from Corsearch Platform(s).

6.7 Products Obtained Using Investigative Services

Customer may request or retrieve test purchases within the scope of the Investigative Services. The purchased items will be Customer's property from the moment of purchase. The Customer acknowledges and agrees that Corsearch shall not keep any products obtained during a test purchase longer than one (1) year following the delivery of the any test purchase. To the extent that Customer refuses or does not claim the test purchases during the one (1) year period, the products of such test purchases shall be disposed. Corsearch does not accept any liability with respect to the disposal of such products.

7. Insurance

Corsearch, by and through its parent and related entity, Corsearch, Inc., has in place and shall, during the Term of the Agreement provide, pay for and maintain in full force and effect, with a reputable insurance company, professional global indemnity insurance with a limit of not less than \$2 million U.S. dollars or the equivalent in the applicable jurisdictional currency.

8. Term and Termination

8.1 Term

8.1.1 This Agreement commences on the Execution Date or, if not specified in the Agreement, the date the Customer first executes the Agreement. It shall continue until all Subscriptions have expired or have been terminated.

8.1.2 The Subscription term for each Service will be set forth in a Statement of Work for the Service. Notwithstanding trial-periods, or otherwise specified in a Statement of Work, the term of each Subscription will automatically renew for additional periods equal to the expiring Subscription term or one year (whichever is longer), unless either Party gives the other written notice (email acceptable) at least sixty (60) days before the end of the relevant, current Subscription term.

8.2 Termination

Either Party may terminate this Agreement for cause: (i) upon 30 days written notice to the other party of a material breach if such breach remains uncured at the expiration of such 30 day period, or (ii) if the other party becomes the subject of a petition of bankruptcy or any other proceeding relating to insolvency, receivership, liquidation or assignment for the benefit of creditors.

8.3 Refund or Payment upon Termination

Termination does not relieve Customer of its obligation to pay fees payable to Corsearch prior to the effective date of termination.

9. Consequences of termination

Upon termination of the Agreement howsoever arising,

(a) the Recipient shall return (or destroy, at the election of the Disclosing Party) such Confidential Information belonging to, or disclosed by, the Disclosing Party in the Recipient's possession or under its control to the Disclosing Party;

(b) the following clauses shall survive the expiration or termination (howsoever arising) of the Agreement: Clause 2 (Licenses, Intellectual Property Rights and ownership), Clause 4 (Financial and payment terms, with respect to any payments owed to Corsearch or any refunds or credits owed to the Customer), Clause 5 (Indemnity), Clause 6 (Liability), Clause 7 (Insurance), Clause 9 (Consequences of termination), Clause 10 (Confidentiality), Clause 11 (Data Protection Terms), Clause 13 (Subpoenas, Legal Orders, Demands or Requests for Information), Clause 14 (Notices), Clause 16 (Entire Agreement), Clause 18 (Governing Law and Disputes).

10. Confidentiality

10.1 Each Party shall keep any Confidential Information received from or belonging to the other Party confidential (using such measures as is necessary in accordance with good industry practice to protect commercially sensitive and confidential information) and not disclose such Confidential Information to anyone (except on a need-to-know basis for internal use only where necessary to perform its obligations under the Agreement to its employees or full time contractors bound (in the case of Corsearch) by express written confidentiality obligations) or use such Confidential Information other than to

- perform its obligations under the Agreement without the prior written consent of the relevant Disclosing Party.
- 10.2 Confidential Information shall in this context mean: (a) all information of a confidential nature concerning the trade secrets or business dealings, methods of business, customers, clients, suppliers, market information, transactions, plans or affairs of a Party, (b) any proprietary information developed by the Parties in the course of carrying out the Agreement, (c) any document or information marked "Confidential," "Commercial in Confidence" or otherwise expressly designated as confidential, (d) in relation to the Customer directly, all Content stored, cached or otherwise contained within the Corsearch Platform(s), and/or (e) any information which by its nature the Recipient ought reasonably to conclude was confidential information of the other Party in all cases whether encrypted or not and including all copies of the above on any media (including electronic media) whatsoever. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Confidential Information shall not include information (a) which is or becomes or is in public domain, without any fault of the Recipient, (b) which was rightfully in the Recipient's possession at the time of disclosure by the Disclosing Party, (c) which is disclosed to the Recipient by a third party or third party source without any obligations of confidentiality after the time of disclosure by the Disclosing Party; or (d) which the Recipient can show, by documentary or competent evidence, to have been developed independently by the Recipient without using Confidential Information of the Disclosing Party.

11. Data Protection Terms

- 11.1 The processing of Personal Data of the Authorized Users of the Customer will be governed by Corsearch Privacy Policy available at the bottom of [Corsearch website](#).
- 11.2 The terms regulating the processing of Personal Data in connection with the Trademark Services is described in our Privacy Policy available at the bottom of [Corsearch website](#).
- 11.3 The processing of Personal Data by each Party, in relation to the Brand Protection, Content Protection, Investigative, Domain Management and Case Management Services as applicable, will be governed by Corsearch's Data Protection Terms available on Corsearch website under [Legal](#), which form part of the Agreement.

12. Force Majeure

- 12.1 Either Party shall not be liable for any delay or failure to carry out its obligations under the Agreement caused by Force Majeure, provided that it promptly gives written notice of the occurrence of the Force Majeure relied on to the other Party and it uses all reasonable endeavours to remove or avoid such Force Majeure as promptly as practicable.
- 12.2 If due to Force Majeure Corsearch is unable to perform its contractual duties for a total of five (5) business days within the invoice period of one month, the fees for that month will be deducted from payment proportionally. If any Force Majeure event relied upon by either Party pursuant to Clause 12 shall have been continually relied upon for more than 60 successive calendar days by such Party, and is continuing, the Parties shall discuss the renegotiation of the Agreement or the other Party shall be entitled to terminate the Agreement with thirty (30) days written notice to the other Party.

13. Subpoenas, legal orders, demands or requests for information

If Corsearch receives a valid search warrant, subpoena, legal order, demand or other request for information regarding the Customer Data or Reports, from any government entity or court with proper jurisdiction over Corsearch, Corsearch shall, to the extent permitted by applicable law:

- (a) immediately notify the Customer of such request;
- (b) consult with the Customer regarding Corsearch's response;
- (c) cooperate with the Customer's reasonable requests in connection with efforts by the Customer to intervene and quash or modify the request; and
- (d) upon the Customer's request, provide the Customer with a copy of Corsearch's response

Subject to Clause 13.1, Corsearch shall comply with any such request, unless such request has been quashed, withdrawn or modified.

The Customer shall reimburse Corsearch for Corsearch's actual costs of complying with any request, including Corsearch's legal fees, provided such request relates to the Customer's actions or a lawsuit involving the Customer or any of its clients.

14. Notice

- 14.1 Any notice under the Agreement will be in writing in the name or on behalf of the Party

- giving it. Notices may be sent by e-mail to the address listed in Section 1 of the Agreement (Customer Details and Controller to Processor Standard Clauses), registered mail, marked for the attention of authorized representative of the Customer and, in the case of Corsearch, for the attention of the CCO or the Chief Legal Officer of Corsearch, Inc., or to such other address as such Party may specify to the other Party in writing from time to time.
- 14.2 A notice will be deemed to have been given:
- (a) at the time of delivery if delivered personally;
 - (b) 48 hours after sent by e-mail.

15. Sub-contracting

Corsearch may sub-contract its obligations under Clause 3.4 (Hosting and Off Site Back Up of Data). Notwithstanding, Corsearch remains liable for any actions or omissions by any Sub-contractors it employs.

16. Entire Agreement

The Agreement, with the applicable subsequent Statements of Work and any Addendums or Schedules thereof, sets out the entire Agreement and understanding between the Parties and supersedes any previous Agreement between the Parties relating to its subject matter. Unless otherwise expressly agreed in writing, the Agreement applies in place of and prevails over any terms or conditions contained in or referred to in correspondence or elsewhere, or implied by trade, custom or course of dealing.

17. General

17.1 Severability

Any term or provision of the Agreement that is invalid or unenforceable in any situation in any jurisdiction shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining terms and provisions hereof or the validity or enforceability of the offending term or provision in any other situation or in any other jurisdiction.

17.2 Waivers

No failure or delay by a Party in exercising its rights or remedies shall operate as a waiver unless made by specific written notice. No waiver by a Party of any default, misrepresentation, or breach of warranty or covenant hereunder, whether intentional or not, shall be deemed to extend to any prior or subsequent default, misrepresentation, or breach of warranty or covenant hereunder or affect in any way any rights arising by virtue

of any prior or subsequent such occurrence. No single or partial exercise of any right or remedy of a Party shall operate as a waiver or preclude any other or further exercise of that or any other right or remedy.

17.3 Independent contractors

The Parties are independent contractors and nothing in the Agreement shall constitute or be deemed to constitute a partnership, joint venture or agency between the Parties; as such neither Party shall have any authority or power to bind, contract in the name of or create a liability for or against the other.

17.4 Amendments

Any amendment to the Agreement shall only be effective if in writing signed by an officer or other duly authorized representative of each of the Parties.

17.5 Assignment

Neither Party may assign or transfer any of its rights or obligations under the Agreement or otherwise dispose of the Agreement without the prior written consent of the other Party, except as otherwise provided for in the Agreement, and to not be unreasonably withheld. Notwithstanding the above, Customer shall be entitled to assign or transfer the Agreement to one of its Affiliates, and Corsearch shall be entitled to assign or transfer the Agreement in connection with a change of control, merger, or sale of all or substantially all of its assets.

17.6 Export Compliance

The Services, other Corsearch technology, and derivatives thereof may be subject to export laws and regulations of the United States, UK, the Netherlands and all other relevant jurisdictions. Corsearch and Customer each represents that it is not named on any U.S. government denied-party list. Customer will not permit any Authorised Person or user of the Services to access or use any Service or Content in a U.S.-embargoed country or region (currently Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Sudan, Syria or Crimea) or in violation of any U.S. export law or regulation.

17.7 Anti-Corruption

Neither party has received or been offered any illegal or improper bribe, kickback, payment, gift, or thing of value from an employee or agent of the other party in connection with this Agreement. Reasonable gifts and entertainment provided in the

ordinary course of business do not violate the above restriction.

18. Governing Law and Disputes

18.1 The Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of: (a) New York, New York if the Customer is located in the United States, with proceedings to take place in Southern District of New York; (b) the Netherlands, if the Customer is located in the European Economic Area (EEA), with proceedings to take place in Amsterdam, Netherlands; or (c) England and Wales, if the Customer is located outside of United States or EEA, with proceedings to take place in London, England.

18.2 Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement, or the breach thereof, shall be settled by joint consultation. If joint consultation does not lead to a resolution, the dispute will be submitted to the responsible persons in the managerial boards of both parties.

18.3 Except as may be required by law, neither a party nor an arbitrator may disclose the existence, content, or results of any arbitration hereunder without the prior written consent of both Parties.
